NOTICE

Please be advised of the following:

- 1. This is only an application for an electrical permit. You do not have a valid permit authorizing electrical work to be performed until it has been separately issued to you and assigned a permit number.
- 2. This permit will not be final until all inspections have been performed and all fees due have been paid.
- 3. Please fill out the application completely to avoid delays in processing.
- 4. The site address *must* be posted at the work or job site and be clearly visible from the road.
- 5. A temporary service has the same requirements for approval as a permanent service.
- 6. The power companies have rules for installation of their equipment and should be consulted for their requirements. If not followed, we cannot release the service to enable you to receive power.
- 7. Rough-in inspection cannot be called for until all boxes are installed, all electrical joints are made, all wires are ran and ground wires are attached.
- 8. Final inspection cannot be called for unless all fixtures are installed and have bulbs, all receptacles and switches are in and have plates installed, all appliances are wired, the circuit panel labeled, is turned on and working.
- 9. Inspectors cannot design your electrical system. You should consult the current Edition of the National Electrical code with State of Michigan amendments for code requirements. Inspectors are available, at designated hours, to interpret the code and provide basic assistance and answer code questions.
- 10. Inspections must be called for through the Building Department at (517) 668-0278. You should provide 24 hours notice and be able to provide the permit number or street address of the job site.

<u>Note</u>: Inspection requests can only be taken from the person the permit was issued to. That individual is also responsible for making sure that the inspector has access to perform the requested inspection and/or for making any arrangements necessary to provide for the same. In addition, an inspector's failure to gain access to perform a requested inspection may result in additional fees being due for extra inspections.

*Observing & following the above should minimize your permit costs & expedite processing your permit!
