Also, Musselman proposed that for 2022, the committee's meeting time be changed from 6 p.m. on the third Tuesday of a meeting month to 3 p.m.

Shepard moved that for 2022, the committee meet at 3 p.m. on the third Tuesday of a meeting month. Seeger seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously on a voice vote.
