As we navigate the public health landscape together, DeWitt Charter Township is continuously monitoring the Coronavirus (COVID-19) closely with the cooperation of federal, state and local health care providers.

At this time, DeWitt Charter Township will be maintaining all essential services. Our Township Hall, Police Department and Fire Department will remain open; however, we will be limiting public interaction. All office location doors will remain closed until further notice for the safety our community, our employees and their families.


We are asking residents to use email, mail, phone, online resources (www.dewitttownship.org) and the Township's drop box to conduct as much business as possible.

To mitigate the risks of Coronavirus (COVID-19), we are implementing the following operational changes.

- 1) We will not be taking any park reservations at this time and all reservations through May 30, 2020, will be refunded. Our Community Parks will remain open without restroom access.
- 2) Police Department will be suspending PBT testing until further notice. Sex offender registrations and gun registrations will be processed by appointment only until further notice. Call the Police Department at (517) 669-6578 to schedule your appointment.
- 3) Building Department will be limiting all non-essential inspections and personal contact during all inspections.
- 4) Sewer payments are to be facilitated through the Township's drop box, online payment, by mail or by phone.
- 5) Fire Department will process Burning Permits online only and Car Seat Installations can be made by appointment (517) 669-0071. All station tours are postponed until further notice.
- 6) The Township will be suspending most Notary Services until further notice. If you have an emergency document that needs to be notarized, please call ahead (517) 668-0270 to discuss options for this service.
- 7) Community Center will be closed to the public until further notice.
- 8) Our Clean Sweep Program, AARP Tax Return preparation and all Peddler's Permits have been suspended until further notice.

Please know that all of us at DeWitt Charter Township are committed to providing the high-quality of service our residents have come to expect in a safe and comfortable environment.
